



# THE ORGAN IN THE EPISCOPAL CHURCH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, VASHON ISLAND

GREAT: Open Diapason 8' 49 open wooden pipes Melodia 8' tc Dulciana 8' tc 49 metal pipes 12 stopped wood pipes Unison Bass 8' 61 metal pipes, low 4 in facade Principal 4' Flute d'Amour 4'

The organ was built by Augustus Barnard Felgemaker of Erie, Pennsylvania in 1896 as his Opus 630, for Bethel Baptist Church (now Westwood Baptist) of Cincinnati, Ohio. According to a plaque on the organ, it was dedicated on September 13, 1896. After the Baptist congregation constructed a new building and converted the old building to other uses, the organ was made available through the Organ Clearing House, Alan Laufman, Director, and purchased by the congregation of Holy Spirit Church, through the advice of Randall McCarty. The organ was removed from the Cincinnati church by Alan Laufman, Randall McCarty, Dana Hull, and Whitney Fletcher, on September 13, 1981, exactly eighty-five years after the dedication services. It has been installed and restored by Randall McCarty, with the help of James Brumbaugh and a number of members of the Holy Spirit congregation.
